Safety Project to Begin on Alhambra Valley Road

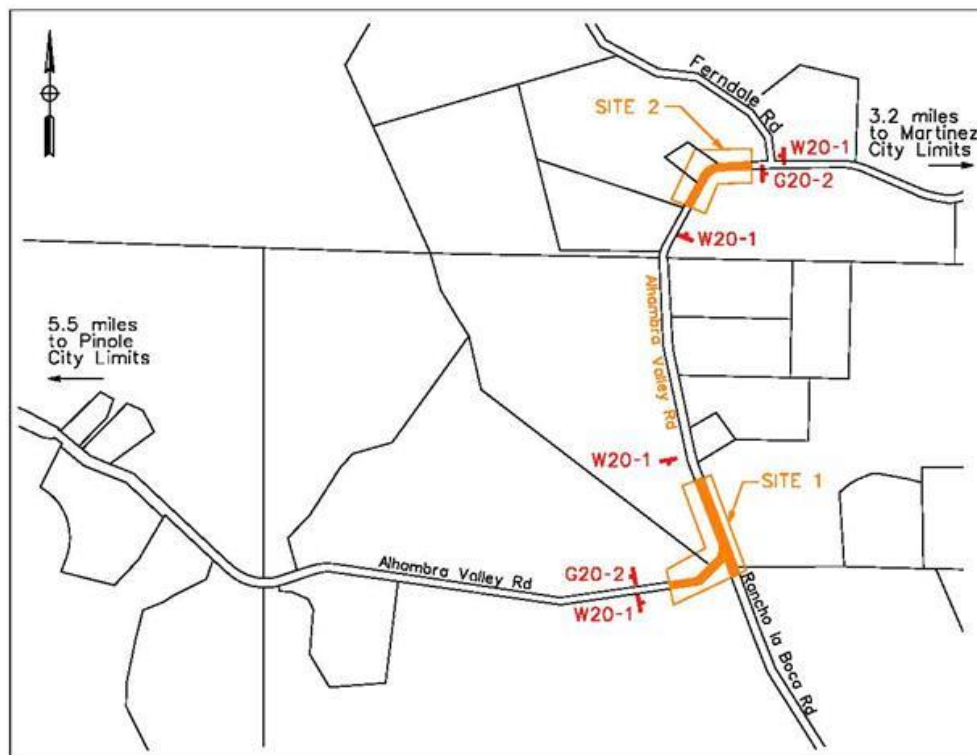
The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors awarded the Alhambra Valley Road Safety Improvements Rancho La Boca to Ferndale Road project to Serafix Engineering Contractors, Inc. The project includes pavement widening at two curves along Alhambra Valley Road in the Martinez area: Site 1 is located at Rancho La Boca Road and Site 2 is 400 feet west of Ferndale Road as shown on the map below. The work will include a wider roadway, shoulders, storm drain improvements, installation of new guardrail, flashing beacon for driver awareness, along with new signing and striping. The contractor will work on one site at a time and one lane will be closed for construction with the other lane open for traffic. A temporary traffic signal will be installed for regulating traffic from both directions. Drivers can expect 5-10 minutes of traffic delay subject to time of travel at the signal. The project is funded through Highway Safety Improvement Program and Martinez Area of Benefit Funds. Work will begin on or about June 12 with completion expected by the end of October.
